MS00400: This class is for graduating seniors only and is designed to help a student in the transition to serving in professional ministry. The class will focus on self-care, writing resumes, developing support systems. We will also help each other evaluate congregations and other settings as part of the interview process				
CA00318: This class will engage practically, critically, and most importantly, PHYSICALLY, theological ideas that touch upon communication, hospitality, freedom, and love. We will revel in our human bodies as pliant instruments for the movement of the Spirit within us and within others. Students will discover numerous ways to introduce movement in their ministry areas beyond worship including pastoral care, preaching, social justice, Christian education, and administration. No movement or dance experience is necessary, but please dress comfortably in order to move freely. The class assumes a basic knowledge of theology and the student's desire to have FUN.				
NT00418: A close exegetical study of the Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew, in comparison with Luke's "Sermon on the Plain." Students will have an opportunity to gain additional exegetical skills as part of the course.

IN00312: The course will examine the biblical teachings on prayer.
