

2010 – 2011 NBTS FINANCIAL AID

Dear NBTS Student:

Enclosed is information about applying for financial aid during the 2010– 2011 academic year at NBTS.

To apply for need-based financial aid at NBTS (NBTS Scholarship and Federal Direct Loans), you need to take the following steps:

- Complete the electronic FAFSA ON THE WEB at www.fafsa.ed.gov . Be sure to enter NBTS' Federal School Code (**G02619**) as one of your college choices.
- Register for at least **six credits** for the upcoming semester.
- Complete NBTS Scholarship application if you apply for scholarship and send it to NBTS Financial Aid Office

In addition, submit a **written statement** with explanation of extenuating circumstances if you apply for NBTS Scholarships.

If this is your first FAFSA, go to www.pin.ed.gov to obtain your PIN. Once you have your PIN, go to www.fafsa.ed.gov to enter your financial information. If you need help, call 1-800-433-3243 or email www.studentaid.ed.gov/complefafsa.

If you provide a valid email address on your FAFSA, your STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR) will come to you electronically through the Web. Carefully review your SAR to ensure all information is correct. NBTS will receive the SAR data a couple of days after you complete FAFSA.

Important notice for renewal aid: If you applied for aid in the 2009-2010 academic year, you must reapply on the Web using the 2010-2011 RENEWAL FAFSA feature at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Much of your application data is carried over from your 2009-10 application so you simply need to review and update it.

*Students may be required to submit documentation of the prior year's income if selected for verification by the Department of Education or the Financial Aid Administrator. Verification or apparent discrepancies in FAFSA data must be resolved prior to disbursement of federal aid.

Application Deadlines. In order for us to determine your eligibility for financial aid, we need all required documents submitted to us by **APRIL 30, 2010**.

Registration. If you are a Direct Loan applicant, your Fall 2010 registration **will not be processed** until you have submitted all the required documents and your loan eligibility is approved by the Financial Aid Office.
