ATLAReligion: Scripture Search

To access ATLAReligion:

- 1. **Web Address**: www.nbts.edu/onlinedatabases This page is password protected. NBTS students, alumni, and staff, or patrons who hold Sage library cards may contact a librarian for login information.
- 2. Click on "Ebscohost Web"
- 3. Click on "ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials

Once you are in the database, click "Scriptures"

You will see a list of all of the books of the bible.

Find the book you need and either click the book for all articles relating to that book, or expand for specific chapter or verse.

The next screen gives a number of scripture citations you might want to include in your search.


1. Check the boxes next to the citations you want to include.

NOTE: Citations that cover only part of the passage you are working with, or the entire chapter in which your passage is located, will often also be helpful.

2. Click "Search"







Note that in our example, the fifth item [1] is in French. To limit your results to English, click **Search Options** [2].

Set the **Language** [1] to English, then click **Search** [2].



The database will remind you that there are **Options set** [1].

Notice that the fourth item is about lectionary readings [2]. To limit your results to scholarly articles click on **Peer reviewed** [3].



The second item in our new list is available as a **PDF** [1]. Click on the link to see (and print) the full text of the article.

The third item is not available full-text [2]. Contact the library for information on how to access such materials.
