Graduation Fee: \$565.00

A graduation fee is charged to all degree candidates. This fee covers the baccalaureate and commencement ceremonies as well as all related costs. The fee is nonrefundable.

A single commencement exercise is held in May of each year to honor students whose degrees are being conferred at that time, have been conferred the previous December, or by **special appeal**, will be conferred in August. All candidates must be approved by the Faculty and presented to the Board of Trustees for a confirming vote.

For the granting of a Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) degree, the candidate must complete the required course work for their concentration, successfully defend their project narrative through a public conversation, and submit a **final copy** of their project narrative (approved by both the Director of the D.Min. program and the Director of the Library) by the second week in May.

For the granting of the M.Div. degree, a student must complete the 84 credit hours of required and elective courses with a GPA of 2.0 or higher including 3 credits of Field Education.

For the granting of the Master of Arts (M.A.) degree, the candidate must complete the 48 hours (for Pastoral Care and Counseling) or 39 hours (for Ministry and Community Leadership) of required and elective courses with a GPA of 3.0 or higher as well as the other requirements of the department.

All potential graduates are required to submit an Application to Graduate. This application must be submitted via scanned copy to gradcom@nbts.edu or sent hardcopy by mail/in person.
