
Scripture Search

2. Click the link for **Online Databases**

2. User ID: **student** Password: **nbts**



3. Click on the link that says **EBSCOHost Research Databases**




4. User ID: **nbts** Password: **library**



5. Click on the link for **EBSCOHost Web** and then click the link for **ATLA Religion Database with ATLA Serials**

6. At the top of the page, note the tabs for viewing the **Publications**, searching by **Scriptures** and viewing the Indexes. Below is a search box where keywords, titles and author's names can be searched.




7. Click on the **Scriptures** tab.

8. The next screen will show a list of all of the books of the bible.

Find the book you need and either click the **Book Title** for all of the articles relating to that book, or click **Expand** to choose a specific chapter or verse.

Note: Each time the **Expand** link is chosen, the number of articles returned decreases; this also may decrease the number of returns with full text available.
