



New Brunswick Theological Seminary Selective Service Appeal Instructions & Application

The Financial Aid Office, not the Selective Service, will determine whether you have shown that your failure to register was not a knowing and willful failure to register. The final decision regarding your eligibility for the benefit that you seek will be made by Financial Aid Office.

If you are a male student and you failed to register with Selective Service before your 26th birthday, you will need to prove to the Financial Aid Office that your non-registration was not *knowing and willful*. To do this, you will need to provide:

1. a **Status Information Letter** from the Selective Service that can be obtained at www.sss.gov, and
2. **additional documentation of the reason(s) that you were not able to register**. You should provide a complete description about your situation, such as where you were living during the period when you should have registered.

Please use the application below to explain why you did not register. A statement may also be attached to the completed application.

Once all the information requested above is received by the Financial Aid Office the financial aid coordinator will convene a Financial Aid Appeals Committee. The committee will decide within 14 business days as to the students' financial aid eligibility.
