Annari Griesel, Ph.D., is the Director of Pastoral Care and Supervisor of Clinical Pastoral Education at Hackensack Meridian Health JFK Medical Center in Edison, NJ, a position she has held since 1996. She has trained and mentored many successful Chaplains. She is an ordained Minister in the Presbyterian Church (USA). Dr. Griesel was among the first women licensed in ministry in the Dutch Reformed Church of South Africa.



Rev. Bernadette Glover, D.Min, is the Senior Pastor of St. Paul Baptist Church in Montclair, NJ. She is a discerning interpreter of church and social issues. As Associate Professor of Preaching and Worship at New Brunswick Theological Seminary, she was recognized for her keen ability to guide her students into seeking deeper understanding of spiritual truths and their call to ministry.



Rev. Elizabeth (Liz) Testa is a pastor, visionary leader, artist and community builder who currently serves as the Reformed Church in America's denominational leader for Women's Transformation and Leadership, a ministry launched in 2014 to help the RCA pursue a vision for the full inclusion of women's gifts and influence in all areas of the church. She helped develop the #sheiscalled campaign.
