CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

CT101 - Old Testament

A study of the historical, cultural, and literary contexts and an introduction to the theological themes in the writings of the Old Testament.

CT108 - Servant Leadership

This course is designed to provide a paradigm for the holistic formation of God's people through preaching, teaching, worship, fellowship, church order, caring and service. A focus on careful congregational/parish analysis and opportunities to develop ministerial skill in various practices of ministry are central to this course.

CERTIFICATE IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES (ONLINE)

CT101 - Old Testament

A study of the historical, cultural, and literary contexts and an introduction to the theological themes in the writings of the Old Testament.

CT102 - Church History

This course will survey the history of Christianity from the end of the Apostolic age to the present, with attention to major themes, persons and events in history of Christian life, thought and institutions.

CERTIFICATE IN EXPOSITORY PREACHING

CT127 - Preaching the Special Occasion

This course covers constructing sermons for funerals, weddings, baptisms and other special occasions. Students will be required to prepare and deliver sermons within these various contexts. Students will be introduced to a variety of methods for the development, delivery and evaluation of sermons.

CT128 - Prophetic Preaching

This course will explore the biblical, theological, historical, and cultural foundations of Prophetic Preaching. This course will be divided into three sections: The Prophets of the Old Testament, The Prophet in the Pulpit, and The Prophet to the Nation. In the first section, we will define Prophetic Preaching and thoroughly investigate the biblical message and practice of prophets in the Old Testament. In the second section, we will explore the role of the prophetic preacher. In the third section, we will explore the needs, responses and practice of prophetic ministry. Because this course is part of the Expository Preaching concentration, we will explore our individual responsibility to preach prophetically as well as develop prophetic ministries.
