

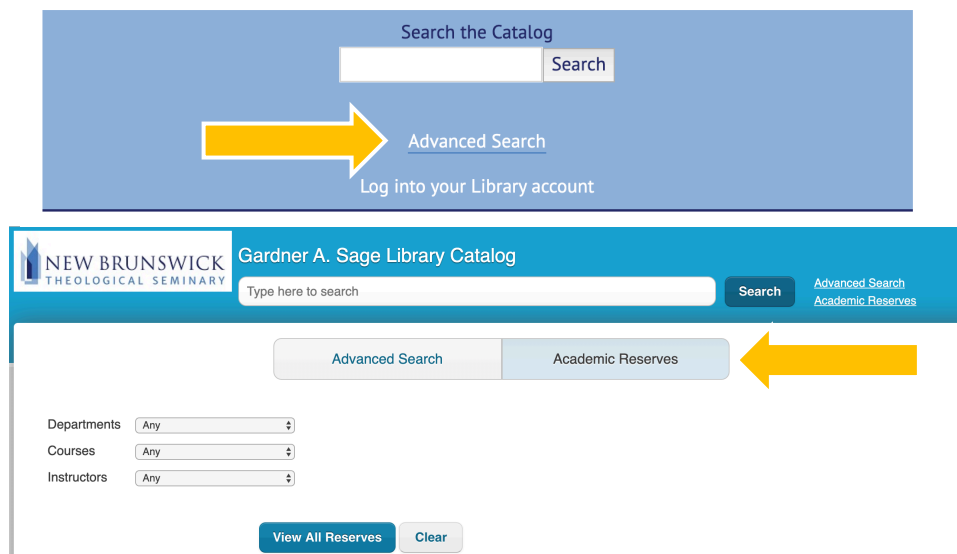
Finding Digital Course Reserves

Begin by navigating to the Sage Library Website at www.nbts.edu/sage-library

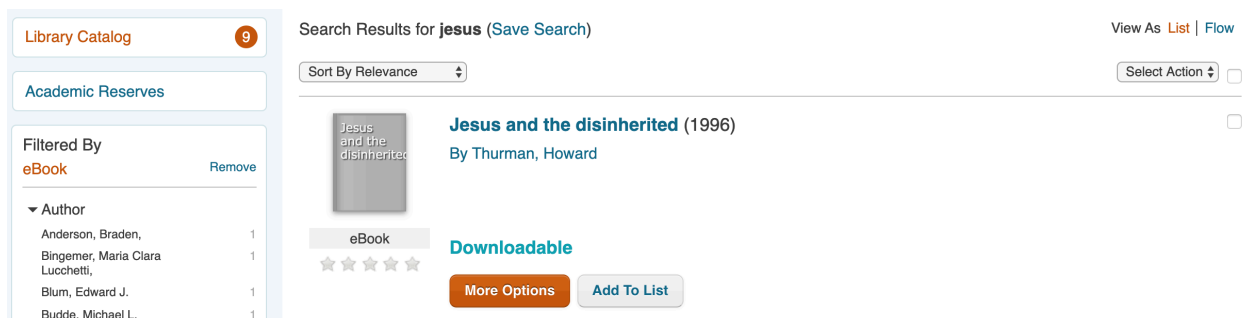
From here you have **two ways of searching** for your course reserves.
